(Hereinafter referred to as "the farm")

GENERAL RULES:

1. Upon arrival, every guest (hunters as well as other guests) will be required to sign and execute a Waiver of Liability and Indemnity.
2. Please refrain from smoking inside the lodge and the tents. All smokers must be cautious, the field is dry and highly flammable, do not discard cigarette buds in the field. R500.00 fine will be applicable for transgressions.
3. No fires are permitted outside the dedicated fireplaces/braai areas in and around the lodge and/or the camp.
4. Guests are to ensure that the fires in dedicated fireplaces/braai areas are completely extinguished before guests retire to their rooms/tents at night.
5. Guests are to ensure that food and dirty dishes are not to remain outdoors after guests retire to their rooms/tents at night as this will attract unwanted mice, snakes, monkeys, baboons, and other animals.
6. The lodge and the camp are self-catering facilities. Rooms and living areas will be serviced/cleaned once a day, and dishes will be washed. Our friendly staff will assist you in every way possible to make your stay with us as memorable, pleasant, and stress-free as possible.
7. Guests are to refrain from littering. All paper and other litter should be collected and discarded at the lodge or camp.
8. VAT will be charged for accommodation and animals hunted at 15%.
9. For full boarding - 30 days prior to arrival booking must be confirmed and fully paid.
10. For self-catering - A non-refundable deposit of 50% payment of daily tariffs confirms your booking.
11. If the deposit is not received within 3 days from making the booking, it will be cancelled automatically.
12. The person, who made the booking and reservation, shall be liable for settling the account and all outstanding payments before departure.

13. Children 0-3 years are free.
14. No refunds on late arrivals or early departures.
15. All cancellations are only effective once confirmed in writing.
16. No Shows: 100% of full amount payable.
17. Cancellations and postponed bookings within 0 – 7 days of date of arrival: 100% payable
18. Cancellations and postponed bookings within 8 - 21 days of date of arrival: 50% of full amount payable
19. Arrival time from 13:00 and departure time before 10:00, later departure can be requested.
20. Late departures will be charged for an additional day tariff.
21. Group bookings: the following cancellation policy will apply to any bookings which exceeds 75% of our capacity.
 - a. Cancellations and postponed bookings within 30 days of date of arrival: 100% of full amount payable
 - b. Cancellations and postponed bookings within 60 days of date of arrival: 50% of full amount payable
22. No motorcycles and quad bikes allowed.
23. Private vehicles are only allowed on the main entry road.
24. No armed firearms allowed on vehicles.
25. Compensation is applicable for any damage caused to property.
26. No firewood to be self-collected from the farm, there will be sufficient wood stacked.
27. No pets allowed.
28. Avoid feeding or touching the wildlife on the farm and the game around the lodge, as it could lead to potential injuries.
29. No meat to be removed from the farm without the relevant transport permits.
30. Hunters & Guests are to refrain from littering. All cartridge shells, paper, and other litter should be collected and discarded at the lodge or camp.
31. Hunters & Guests are to arrange with the PH for daily hunting programs. The front of house staff will attend to all kitchen and housekeeping duties.
32. Always respect the farm's staff, they are under full instruction of the Manager/Directors.

HUNTING RULES:

1. No hunting will be permitted unless or until a hunter signs and executes this Waiver of Liability and Indemnity.
2. All hunters to be in possession of a valid firearms license, if a hunter does not have a license, he or she may ONLY handle a weapon under instruction of the PH.
3. All firearms to be locked in safe when not in use.
4. Carrying of handguns are allowed as per law – concealed. Handguns shall also be locked away when not in use.
5. Hunting will only be permitted from sunrise to 17H00 daily. No hunting allowed on Sundays.
6. Hunters are required to shoot in their rifles the day before or the morning when hunting will commence.
7. Hunters are not permitted to hunt antelope bigger than Impala with ammunition loads smaller than 150 grains.
8. Hunting with a caliber rifle smaller than .270 is not permitted.
9. The use of alcohol during hunting is strictly prohibited, and no persons under the influence of alcohol will be permitted to use a firearm or drive a vehicle.
10. Hunting directly from or within 300 meters from a hunting vehicle will not be permitted.
11. No hunting within 500 meters of the lodge and camp will be permitted.
12. During all hunting activities, hunters shall be accompanied and be supervised by a field guide. No hunters will be permitted to hunt without being accompanied by a field guide.
13. Only game species specified in the hunting list as provided may be hunted. No rounds may be fired at any plants, trees, or other animal or bird not specified in the hunting list provided. A penalty shall be payable should an animal or bird not specified in the hunting list provided be shot.
14. Any game wounded and not located will be deemed as legitimately hunted by the hunter, and the hunter shall be liable to pay the listed price for the animal concerned. Any blood, bone, hide, flesh, or hair of an animal which may be found will be deemed to constitute satisfactory proof that the animal had been wounded and in some cases in the discretion of the PH even if no blood can be found.
15. If an animal has been wounded, it will be the responsibility of the hunter concerned with the assistance of the field guides to locate the wounded animal. All reasonable efforts shall be made to locate a wounded animal.
16. The hunter concerned shall not be permitted to continue with hunting activities until a wounded animal has been located or until a field guide decides that a wounded animal cannot be located despite all reasonable efforts to locate such an animal.
